Our Work:

- ★ We **communicate information to residents** on events and local news through our email newsletter.

Inclusive Communities and Safety & Security Committees - we made progress in mobilizing our community, creating awareness and improving understanding by engaging on substance use health and addiction treatment, and the broader systemic issues behind neighbourhood challenges, and ongoing efforts to support neighbours in need. We continue to advocate for provincial regulation to better regulate how addiction treatment is prescribed and dispensed.

Our Committees:

We have very active committees of volunteers working on lots of different topics: Advocacy, Arts, Environment, Communications, Gardening, Heritage & History, Inclusive Communities, Membership, Safety & Security, Sponsorship, Supper Club, Transportation, and Zoning.

We also tackle many other topics and have HCA representatives on 10+ external organizations. New energy is always welcome.

Our Highlights:

- 17th Hintonburg 1K/5K race sold out with overwhelming volunteer support, raised more than \$2,400 for free youth programming.
- Held popular annual events like ArtsPark and Craft Fair.
- Partnered with CAFES and Carleton University students to develop information products about pollinator plants.
- Worked with volunteers in Cleaning the Capital.
- Continued to work with the city and local residents to help shape the soon to be expanded Armstrong Park.
- Ongoing work with various partners to increase the tree canopy along Wellington St W and Scott Streets.
- Led three tours of historic Hintonburg for Jane's Walk, and held the first Hintonburg Histories evening and provided research in support of designation of 1121 Wellington St W.
- Held speaker events on support for persons with disabilities, addiction, and substance use health and compassionate action.
- Highlighted and celebrated diversity in our community in the HCA newsletter.
- Worked with the City on vacant and derelict properties.
- Supported local restaurants - the Supper Club invites people to go to different locations in Hintonburg every month. A great way to meet neighbours!
- Collected residents' input on solutions for Parkdale traffic congestion and are now advocating to the city for change.
- Continued work on Plouffe Park rezoning/site plan and Tunney's Pasture redevelopment.
- Active work in advancing objectives in affordable housing and community benefits by defining requirements and policies for development.
- Generated a baseline socio-economic and physical profile of the Hintonburg community.
