HINTONBURG COMMUNITY SURVEY: THE RESULTS ARE IN!

Thank you to everyone who participated— the number of responses far exceeded our expectations, with more than 650 residents sharing their views. While **85% of respondents said they "very much" enjoy living in Hintonburg**, the survey also highlighted concerns and ideas for improvement on issues such as affordable housing, traffic congestion, cyclist and pedestrian safety, and neighbourhood densification. HIGHLIGHTS FROM THIS PAST YEAR:

- Held 18th Hintonburg 1K/5K races (sold out) with overwhelming volunteer support, raised about \$1,000 for free local programming for youth.
- Held popular annual events like ArtsPark and Craft Fair.
- Worked with volunteers in Cleaning the Capital.
- Maintained gardens in the parks and greenspaces at Parkdale, McCormick, Bayview, Somerset Square and in front of the Hintonburg Community Centre. Supported the gardeners at the Marché Garden and the seniors at 1041 Wellington.
- Gave away free trees to 42 homes in Hintonburg.
- Led three tours of historic Hintonburg for Jane's Walk, and a fourth tour is planned for September.
- Held the second Hintonburg Histories evening and added to the 23 heritage properties in the Hintonburg Histories History Pin. www.hintonburg.com/hintonburg-histories
- Invested in affordable housing through purchase of Housing Forever Bonds in Ottawa Community Land Trust and Centretown Citizens Ottawa Corporation, and donated to the ODENAK project as part of the Multifaith Housing Initiative.

- Continued work on the issue of predatory addiction clinics with other communities, the one in Hintonburg relocated to Chinatown and has created the same problems there.
- Provided City staff with a detailed list of dangerous deficiencies on the sidewalks and crosswalks; most have been fixed over the last two months.
- Supported local restaurants - the Supper Club invites people to go to different locations in Hintonburg every month. It's a great way to meet neighbours!
